- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Submit completed Phlebotomy School Application for Admission.
- Submit signed Statement of Understanding for Essential Requirements. (Submit only the signature page.)
- Submit one copy of:
 - High school transcript (2.5 or higher GPA) or
 - GED scores (530 or higher) or
 - HiSET scores (60 or higher)
- Submit two letters of reference/recommendation. One letter MUST be a professional reference, i.e. supervisor, employer, professor, teacher, etc.
- Submit a personal statement explaining your interest in phlebotomy. One to two paragraphs are sufficient.
- OPTIONAL: Copy of transcript from additional schools attended.
